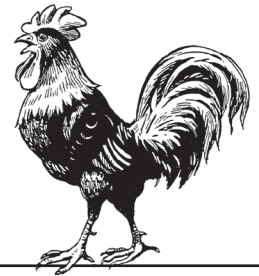

Put on your armor

Sadly enough, Satan is alive and well in this world and continues to throw darts at our Emmaus Community. Daily I contend with this and when I do I like to turn to the passage in Ephesians 6: 10 & 11; "Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes."

Under Armour sports performance apparel has become one of the hottest brands in sports. They have "engineered" apparel for athletes to protect them from the cold, the heat and the turf. They even offer performance underwear!!! Athletes from the NFL to NASCAR and even the military wear this gear to protect themselves from the elements and also to enhance their performance.

But just as we protect our bodies through intense physical training, we must also protect our hearts and minds by putting on our spiritual armor. If we step on to a playing field without being prepared physically, our opponent will dominate the competition, and we expose ourselves to a greater risk for injury. If we step onto life's playing field without the "full armor of God" then our opponent, Satan, is very likely to push us all over the field. We are at risk for moral failure and become a liability to our team - the team of Jesus Christ.

At Emmaus, we are part of Jesus's team. And we need to make sure we have our armor on at all times. We always say as part of the 4th Day talk (and that's what Emmaus is all about) that the closer we get with God, the more Satan attacks us. Therefore put on the belt of truth, the breastplate of righteousness, shod your feet with readiness, take up your shield of faith and put on your helmet of salvation. The last two pieces Paul tells us to wear is the sword of the spirit, which is the word of God, and to pray. Stay in God's word and prayer for each other and God will give us the victory.

So what I am going to do as we head into a new year and me being a new President of your Board, is ask each of you to put on your armor, the armor of God. Stay in His Word (The Holy Bible) and pray. Pray, not for our will to be done, but for God's will to be done in our personal lives and in the life of this community.
