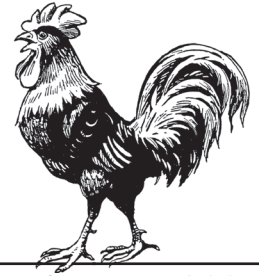

Seek to glorify God through Emmaus and Chrysalis

“But you, O LORD, sit enthroned forever; your renown endures through all generations.” Psalms 102:12 (NIV)

God is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow. Everything else is subject to change. I was born in 1950, before my family had television or even a telephone. In these few 57 years, what changes have we seen in politics, society, technology, our different professions and avocations? Do we farm today as we did in 1950? Or teach school as we did in 1950? Or practice medicine? Or law? Do we worship God as we did in 1950? I venture to say that much of our Sunday morning service is similar to what we did in 1950 but has substantial differences. During the following weeks, months and years, as we prepare to participate in Emmaus Walks and Chrysalis Flights, let us pray to God that every action we take and every word we speak, will point to God's glory and not our own.
