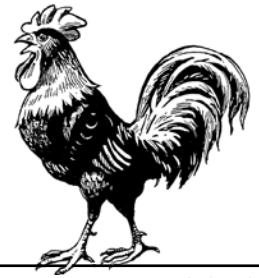

The Armor of God

Do you remember your original three day “walk”? Can you recall the feeling of the Holy Spirit moving through the conference room, the little church, the chapel during candlelight and into your heart? Add to that the feeling of being protected by the almighty God against all the evil in the world as you traveled on the “walk” during the weekend. Remember the overwhelming sense of peace that allowed you to clearly see truth and righteousness? Would you like to “feel” that way again???? You can...with the Armor of God.

Ephesians 6: 10-17 specifically instructs us in how this is possible.
